



Avoid Requests for Revision! Is My Paper Formatted Correctly?

NOTE: The final PDF is “camera-ready”. The author information on the final paper is the information that will appear in publication. Unsolicited revisions will NOT be accepted.

CHECKLIST:

Author Section

- ✓ The paper title is correct, free of spelling and typographical errors
- ✓ All authors of the paper are accounted for. No new authors have been added, and no author listings have been forgotten. **Authors cannot be added after acceptance of the draft. Removal of an author will require written agreement from all co-authors.**
- ✓ Author listings are shown in the correct order from left to right across the page, or shown using numbered superscripts.
- ✓ Author names are consistent with what is on the copyright form, shown as they should appear in copyright/publication/indexing, spelled correctly. No nicknames.
- ✓ Author names are shown in First Name Last Name format. Last names are spelled fully and not represented by initials.
- ✓ The affiliation shown on the paper is listed as it should appear in copyright/publication/indexing. If you completed your copyright agreement as an employee of the US Government or US Government Contractor, please be sure to list that institution as your primary affiliation.
- ✓ No contact information (mailing address, phone number, email address) is shown in the author section. The contact author can list his/her email address in a footnote at the bottom left of the first page.
- ✓ A City, Country or City, State (US) location is listed for each affiliation.
- ✓ The author section is formatted or condensed as necessary so that it does not take up the whole page.

Body of the Paper

- ✓ The text of the paper is formatted to fit the 2-column template, including the abstract.
- ✓ There is no use of highlighter, color font, or reviewer comments in the text.
- ✓ The text is single-spaced in regular font. The whole text should not be in italics.

- ✓ There is no non-English language text in the paper.
- ✓ The margins are correctly sized per the ASME template. Text does not interfere with the gutter margin of space between the columns.

Equations

- ✓ Equations are numbered correctly and sized to fit the width of the column.
- ✓ Equation characters and symbols are pasted clearly and correctly. No corrupt font.

Tables and Graphics

- ✓ Graphics are sized to fit the width of the column and do not interfere with the side or center margins.
- ✓ Graphics are not surrounded by wrapped text. They stand on their own within the column.
- ✓ Graphics and/or tables are not broken over two columns or two pages.

- ✓ The reference section is incorporated into the 2-column format shown in the template.
- ✓ Citations are formatted according to the [References](#) guidelines shown in the [ASME Conference Publications Author Guidelines](#)
