### **Important Information for TE21 Authors**

#### **New Conference Format**

In response to the interest from Turbo Expo attendees for more live content, more networking opportunities, and an improved experience with the Turbo Expo virtual platform, a new and robust conference format was formed by the <u>Turbo Expo Organizing Committee</u>, the <u>IGTI Executive Committee</u>, and the <u>Gas Turbine Segment Leadership Team</u>.

This new and robust conference format will provide all authors of final papers the opportunity to create a 30-minute video on-demand presentation of their paper. See the <u>recorded</u> <u>presentation submission instructions</u>. The video presentation will be available on-demand, on the virtual event platform, one week prior the official start day of the virtual conference, during the conference, and 90 days post-conference. The early video viewing availability will allow attendees to come to the conference prepared with author questions which will facilitate the "live networking" intended to improve the conference experience. Additionally, details of the new virtual format are given below.

# **Technical Paper Sessions**

- All TE21 paper sessions will be 1.5 hours long (90 minutes) and accommodate 5 papers as described below, which will be based upon the paper reviews.
- Question and Answer after each presentation
- *Live* 5-paper sessions
  - First two papers in each session will be Live Deep Dive Talks
    - 30-minute live presentation which includes 10 minutes of question and answer, per paper.
  - o The three papers given next in each session will be **Live Rapid Talk** presentations
    - 10-minute live presentation which includes 8-minutes summarizing their main paper's results, plus 2 minutes for question and answer, per paper.
- Networking Round Table discussions can be organized anytime (round the clock) to meet any time-zone and enhance interactions.
- Authors will be notified about which type of live presentation (Deep Dive or Rapid Talk) slot they have by March 30, 2021.

#### **Other Important Virtual Conference Improvements**

- Video on Demand (VOD) will be available one week prior to the official start date of the conference (May 31, 2021).
- The papers will be available on the virtual event platform. You will not have to connect to a different site to view the papers.
- There will be a pdf version of the technical session schedule.
- Attendees will be able to see who is in each session.
- Improved network discussions via the networking Round Tables in the 24-hour virtual platform. *Information on how you can create these will be available soon.*
- List of all authors will be included in the virtual platform.
- Inclusion of tutorials and panels

#### **Virtual Event Information**

- Virtual event dates are June 7 11, 2021.
- The conference time will be sessions will run from 8:00 am EST to 5:30 pm EST. Similar to a physical Turbo Expo conference, there will be parallel sessions and breaks.
